Safeguarding Support

Pastoral / Therapeutic Support

This work is based on the providing the students stability and consistency of their relationships with our staff.

Keeping in touch

This includes a weekly individual call from a member of the pastoral team and a weekly touch base online meeting. Further support is put in place where individuals need it.

Therapeutic support

This includes support from our SEND team to offer Draw and Talk, Lego Therapy and other therapeutic interventions. This also includes a therapeutic reading offer with either e-readers, wellbeing books or magazine subscriptions. We also have access to have online counselling sessions if this is needed..

Other support

This includes food vouchers, continuing our Amazon reward voucher scheme and providing details for Kooth support. We are always looking for more ways to support our students, so this is regularly added to.
